Psalm 107

New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)

- 1 O give thanks to the Lord, for he is good,
for his steadfast love endures forever.**
- 2 Let the redeemed of the Lord say so,
those he redeemed from trouble**
- 3 and gathered in from the lands,
from the east and from the west,
from the north and from the south.**
- 4 Some wandered in desert wastes,
finding no way to an inhabited town;**
- 5 hungry and thirsty,
their soul fainted within them.**
- 6 Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble,
and he delivered them from their distress;**
- 7 he led them by a straight way,
until they reached an inhabited town.**
- 8 Let them thank the Lord for his steadfast love,
for his wonderful works to humankind.**
- 9 For he satisfies the thirsty,
and the hungry he fills with good things.**
